On the Resource Corner page there are two break even cost sheets that you can plug your own numbers into. I have put one together here for corn, soys, drybeans, wheat and beets. The numbers are pretty interesting. I used current fertilizer prices and current chemical prices. I also used averages for yield. The prices per bushel are figured on todays prices as well. The fixed costs portion of the sheet is just averages for what farmers may need for fuel and other costs. Farmers should use a sheet like this to figure out their crop rotation for the next year.
